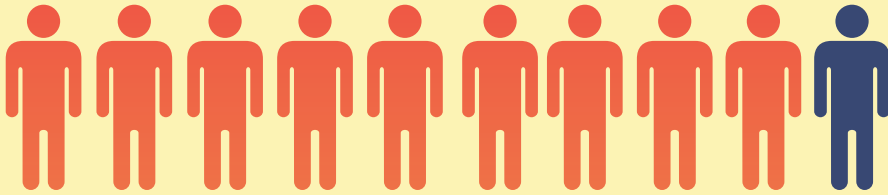


Thrive for Youth Education Program Outcomes and Impacts 2016/2017



I'm using a part of my brain I haven't used in a long time. This helps me in real life to think more rationally and understand things better."

Of the 5 former participants interviewed who completed their GED at Thrive:

- 3 have continued on to post-secondary
- 1 has completed a college diploma and is working in their chosen field
- 1 is currently attending college full-time
- 1 is currently attending university part-time

Pass rate for GED exam
Is **90-100%**

13 youth have received GED diploma
2 youth gained 6 high school credits



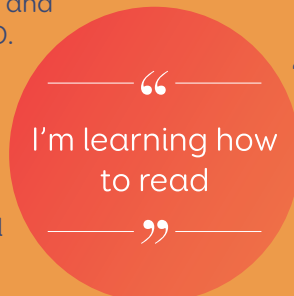
{ Youth/participants have more positive attitudes toward learning and education }

"I haven't been to school in five years and I've already done one part of the GED. It's pretty amazing"

"They had a big impact on my kids regarding their education"

"He got it in his head to stay in school because of that group"

"I'm more determined to do it. I dropped out of school in grade 9 and no one could get me back"



"It's not as hard as I thought it would be"

"This is a good place for people who have a bad past or mental illness."

"I know I'm capable of doing school now"

When I came here, I didn't know how to subtract.



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Youth/participants have increased confidence and self-concept.

84% of Education program participants agreed.

Youth/participants have enhanced employability and opportunities.

52% of Education program participants report this.



Youth/participants have improved knowledge of and connection to community resources.

79% of Education participants reported this.

Youth/participants have expanded social networks and positive influences.

100% Education program participants reported this.

Youth/participants have increased their awareness and uptake of health and other support services.

53% of Education participants reported this.

Youth/participants have increased optimism about their future.

100% of Education participants reported



Youth/participants have an improved relationship with their family.

79% of Education participants reported this.

Youth/participants view Thrive as a supportive and positive resource.

100% of Education program participants reported this.
