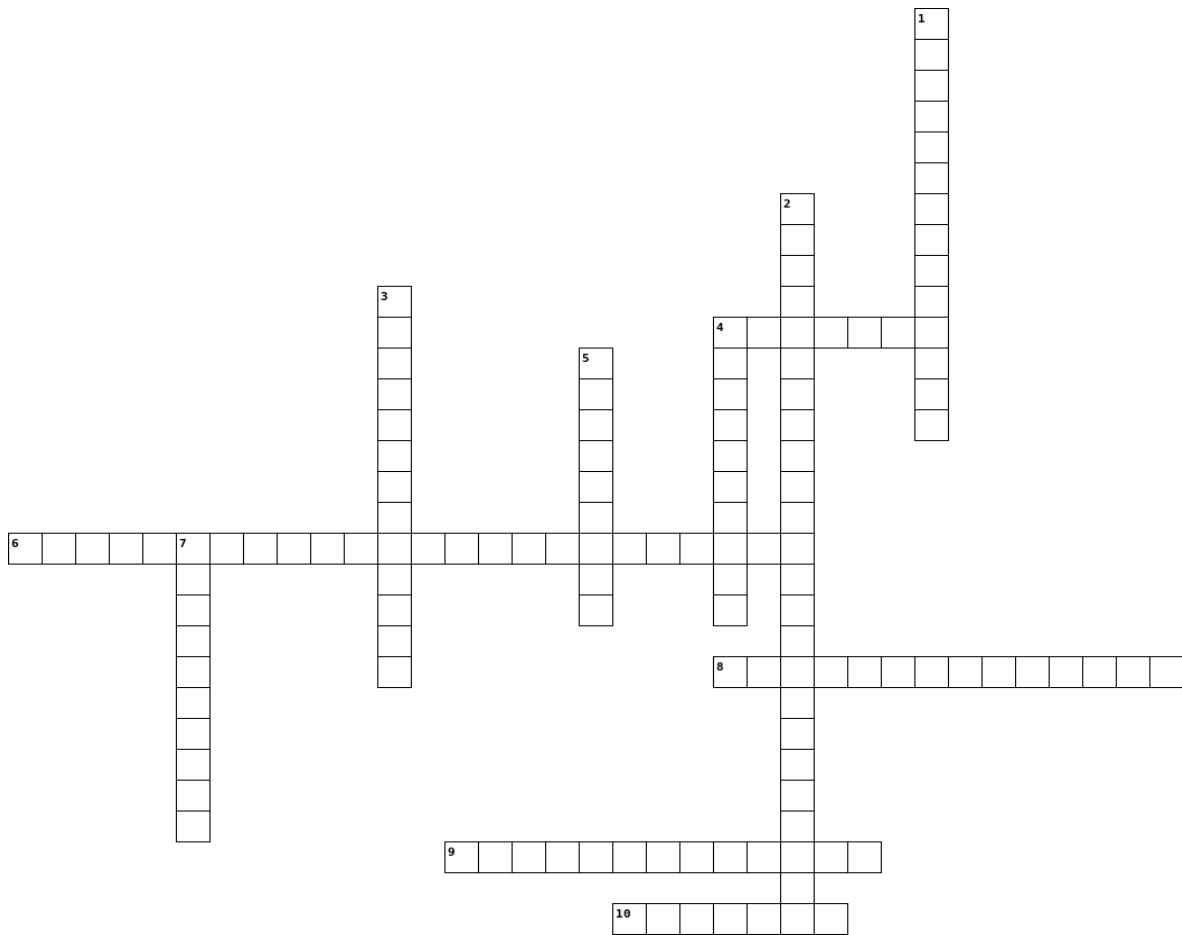


# Module 1: Terminology
